Pat, I hope this email finds you well. Great Wolf Lodge is proposing to construct a facility within Mashantucket. Nothing fancy, but their PTE for NOx & CO exceeds our Minor NSR Thresholds. Per the TIP we need to provide notice to EPA (in the past I have simply sent an email to Ida, but let me know if something more formal is preferred).
